



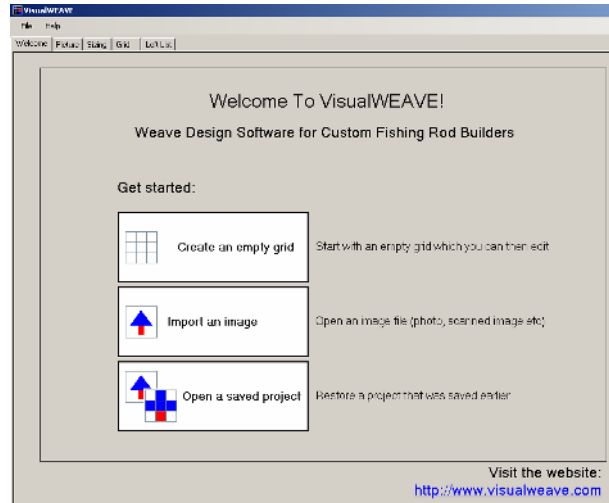

Quick Start Lesson –
"Create a Simple Left List"

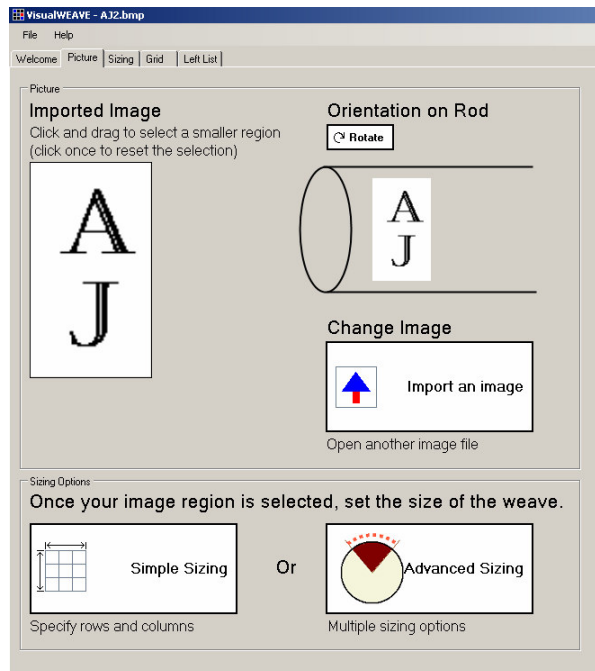
The aim of this lesson is to:

- Import a picture file,
- Size it to 50 threads high using C wrapping thread and A pattern threads
- Create a Left List

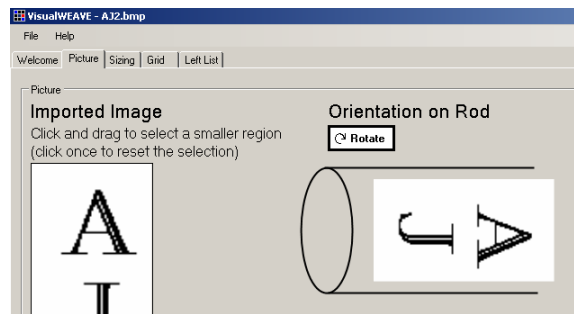
1. Click on "Import an Image"



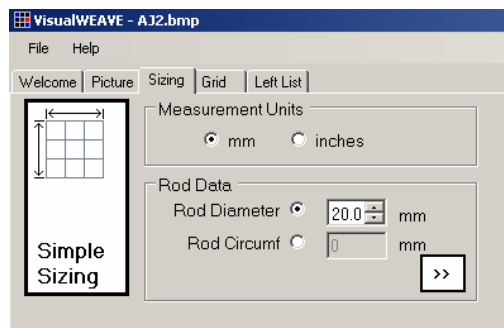
2. Load AJ.bmp from the Samples folder



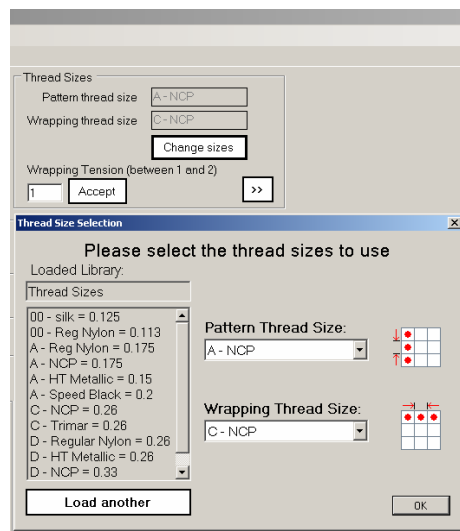
3. Rotate the image by 90 degrees



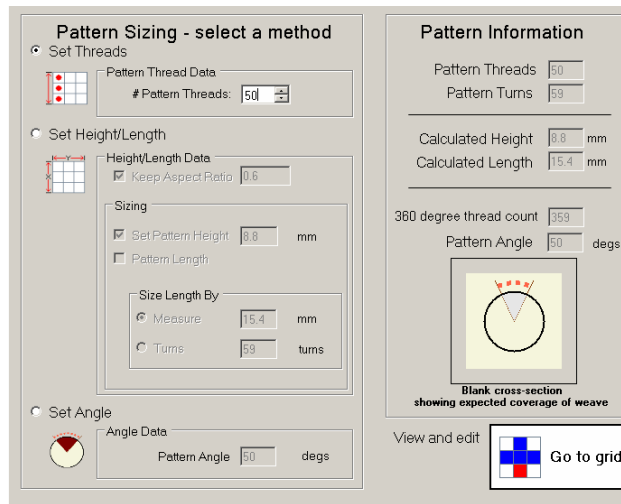
4. Select Advanced Sizing. Use the default of 20mm rod diameter.



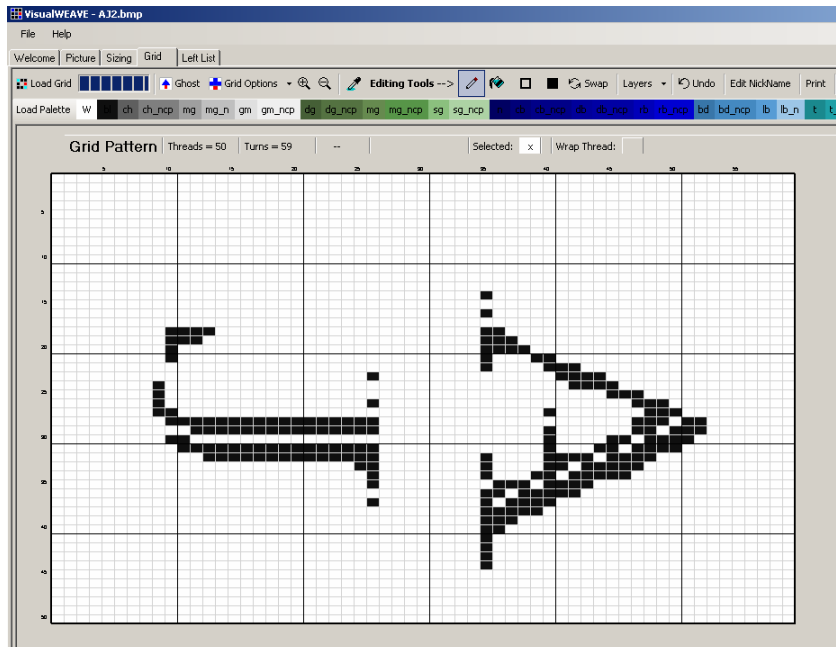
5. Click ">>", load a Thread Size file by clicking "Change Sizes" and select A - NCP for Pattern Thread and C - NCP for Wrapping Thread



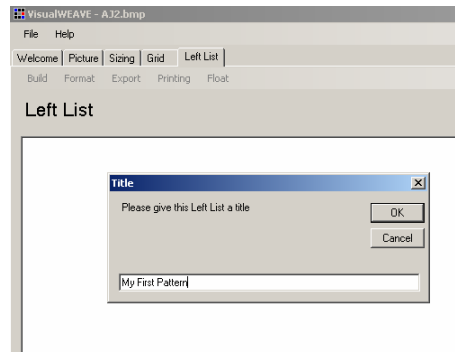
6. Click ">>" then using the Set Threads sizing method set the size to 50 threads. Note the Pattern Turns are automatically set to 59.



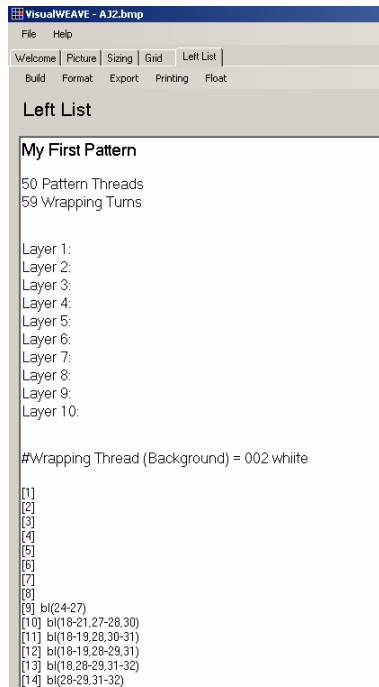
7. click on "Go to grid". The grid image should be automatically created (you will be prompted first – click OK". Click on the Zoom Out button once.



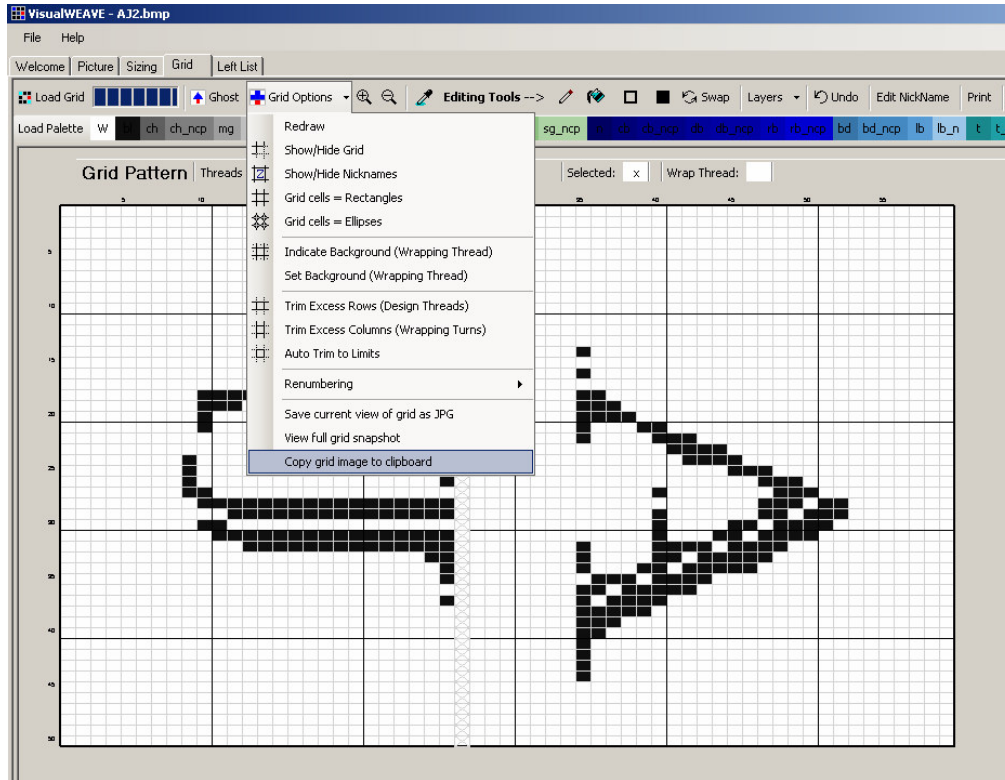
- You can tidy up the grid using the grid editing tools at your leisure. Assign the wrapping thread to be White by right-clicking on a white cell then selecting "Select this colour as background (wrapping thread)". Acknowledge the popup that appears. Now click on the Left List tab, then click on the Build menu tem. You will be prompted to enter a title. Type the title and then click OK



- Say "No" to coloured text and "Yes" to using Nicknames.



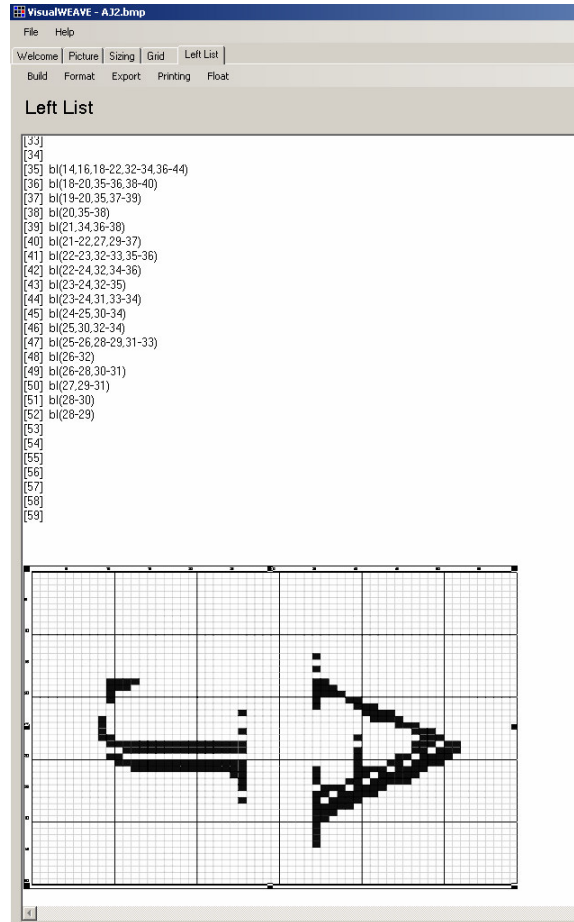
10. Voila – you have generated a Left List. You can edit it by highlighting text, deleting, using the Format menu, etc. Try the following: go back to the Grid page, click on the “Grid Options” drop down button, then “Copy grid image to clipboard”.



11. Go back to the Left List. Left-click on the blank line under the text “59 Wrapping Turns”. Right-click and select “Paste”. The grid image will be pasted into the Left List. Unfortunately it is too big and gets pasted at the end of the list. Click on the newly-inserted image and notice there is a selection window around it, with darker selection boxes on the corners and mid-way along each side. Click and drag one of the corner selection boxes then release the mouse so as to resize the image and make it smaller.

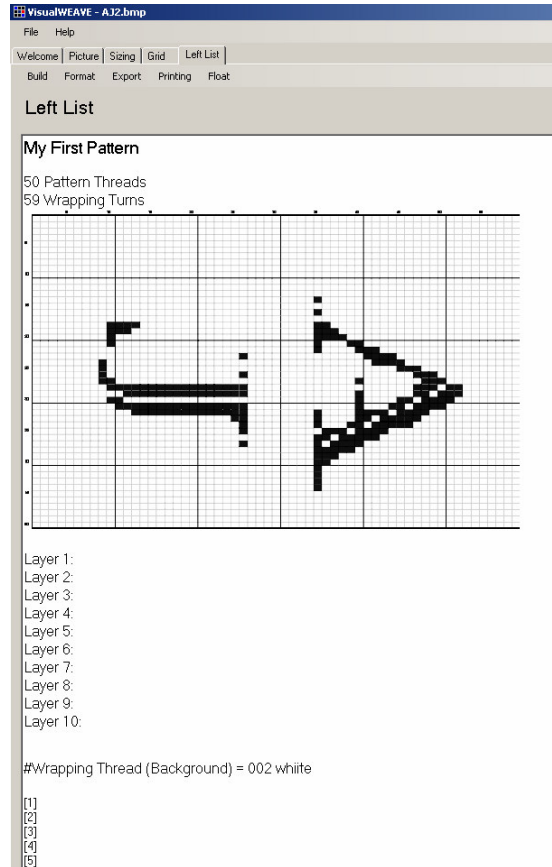

12. Once happy with the size, click on the image once to select it, hit ctrl-x to cut it, scroll up to the top of the Left List, left click on the blank line under the text "59 wrapping turns", then hit ctrl-v to paste the image.
